

What is Erasmus Mundus - Al Idrisi?

Erasmus Mundus - Al Idrisi is a scholarship scheme for exchange and cooperation between Europe and the Maghreb. It is an *Erasmus Mundus Action 2* project which organizes and manages scholarships financed by the European Commission for members of the *Al Idrisi* partner universities and nationals from Algeria, Morocco and Tunisia. Selected grantees may follow a credit transfer, short stay or full degree programme at one of the partner universities.

What are the aims of Erasmus Mundus - Al Idrisi?

- ★ To allow undergraduate and master students, doctoral candidates, post-doctoral fellows as well as academic and administrative staff to gain valuable experience, knowledge and contacts abroad.
- ★ To provide improved education and training opportunities for vulnerable groups and socio-economically disadvantaged students, and promote equal access to higher education for students from least developed regions.
- ★ To exchange knowledge, know-how and experience between Europe and the Maghreb reinforcing the teaching and research capacities of the partner universities.
- ★ To promote common areas of higher education.

How does the scholarship scheme work?

*for nationals from EU countries

If you are enrolled at a European partner university you can apply for:

- ★ Credit transfer programmes (undergraduate, master)
- ★ Short stays (doctorate, post-doctorate, academic and administrative staff)

*for nationals from Algeria, Morocco and Tunisia

If you are enrolled at a partner university in Algeria, Morocco or Tunisia you can apply for:

- ★ Credit transfer programmes (undergraduate, master)
- ★ Full degree programmes (master, doctorate)
- ★ Short stay programmes (doctorate, post-doctorate, academic and administrative staff)

If you are enrolled or registered at a higher education institution in Algeria, Morocco or Tunisia not included in the *Al Idrisi* partnership you can apply for:

- ★ Full degree programmes (master, doctorate)
- ★ Short stay programmes (post-doctorate)

If you have obtained a university degree in Algeria, Morocco or Tunisia you can apply for:

- ★ Full degree programmes (master, doctorate)
- ★ Short stay programmes (post-doctorate)

If you can prove that you are in a particularly vulnerable situation you can apply for:

- ★ Credit transfer programmes (undergraduate)

How to apply?

If you want to apply for an *Erasmus Mundus - Al Idrisi* scholarship, you must fill in the online application available on the *Al Idrisi* website:

All undergraduate, master, doctoral and post-doctoral mobility flows must have started by 31 December 2012. The deadline for the start of academic and administrative staff mobility is 30 September 2013.

What does the scholarship cover?

The scholarship covers a monthly allowance, tuition fees, travel expenses (one economy class round trip) health, travel and accident insurance coverage.

Level of mobility	Duration	Monthly allowance
Undergraduate	6 or 10 months	1,000 €
Master	6, 10, 12 or 24 months	1,000 €
Doctorate	6 or 36 months	1,500 €
Post-doctorate	6 months	1,800 €
Staff	1 month	2,500 €

What disciplines are offered?

All partner universities offer a wide range of disciplines. As *Erasmus Mundus - Al Idrisi* focuses strongly on regional needs, the following specific thematic areas will be given priority in the selection process:

- ★ Business Studies and Management Sciences
- ★ Engineering, Technology
- ★ Geography, Geology
- ★ Languages
- ★ Mathematics, Informatics
- ★ Medical Sciences
- ★ Natural Sciences
- ★ Social Sciences
- ★ Communication and Information Sciences

Administrative staff mobility is also considered a priority for the *Erasmus Mundus - Al Idrisi* partnership.
