What is Erasmus Mundus – Al Idrisi II ?

Erasmus Mundus - Al Idrisi II is a scholarship scheme for exchange and cooperation between Europe and North Africa. It is an *Erasmus Mundus Action 2* project which organizes and manages of Al Idrisi II partner and associate universities and nationals from Algeria, Egypt, Libya, Morocco, Tunisia and European Union. Selected grantees may follow a credit transfer, short stay or full degree programme at one of partner universities.

What are the aims of Erasmus Mundus – Al Idrisi II?

- ❖ To allow undergraduate, master and doctoral students, post-doctoral fellows and academic and administrative staff to gain valuable experience, knowledge and contacts abroad.
- ❖ To provide improved education and training opportunities for vulnerable groups and socio-economically disadvantaged students and promote equal access to higher education for students from less developed areas.
- ❖ To exchange knowledge, know-how and experience between Europe and North Africa reinforcing the teaching and research capacities of the partner universities.
- ❖ To set up International Cooperation Cells in research, teaching and administration.
- ❖ To promote common areas of higher education.

How does the scholarship scheme work?

→ for nationals from EU countries

If you are enrolled or registered at an European partner university you can apply for:

- ❖ Credit transfer programmes (undergraduate)
- ❖ Short stays (doctorate, post – doctorate, academic and administrative staff)

→ for nationals from Algeria, Egypt, Libya, Morocco and Tunisia

If you are enrolled or registered at a North African partner university you can apply for:

- ❖ Credit transfer programmes (undergraduate)
- ❖ Full degree programmes (master, doctorate)
- ❖ Short stays (doctorate, post – doctorate, academic and administrative staff)

How to apply?

If you want to apply for an Erasmus Mundus – Al Idrisi II scholarship, you must fill in the online application available on the Al Idrisi website:

What does the scholarship cover?

Erasmus Mundus - Al Idrisi II scholarships cover the following items: a monthly allowance, tuition fee, health, travel and accident insurance and expenses for one economy class round-trip.

Level of Mobility	Duration	Monthly allowance
Undergraduate	6 or 10 months	1.000 €
Doctorate	6 months	1.500 €
Post - doctorate	6 months	1.800 €
Staff	1 month	2.500 €

All partner universities offer a wide range of disciplines. As *Erasmus Mundus - Al Idrisi II* focuses strongly on regional needs in North Africa, the following specific thematic areas will be given priority in the selection process:
