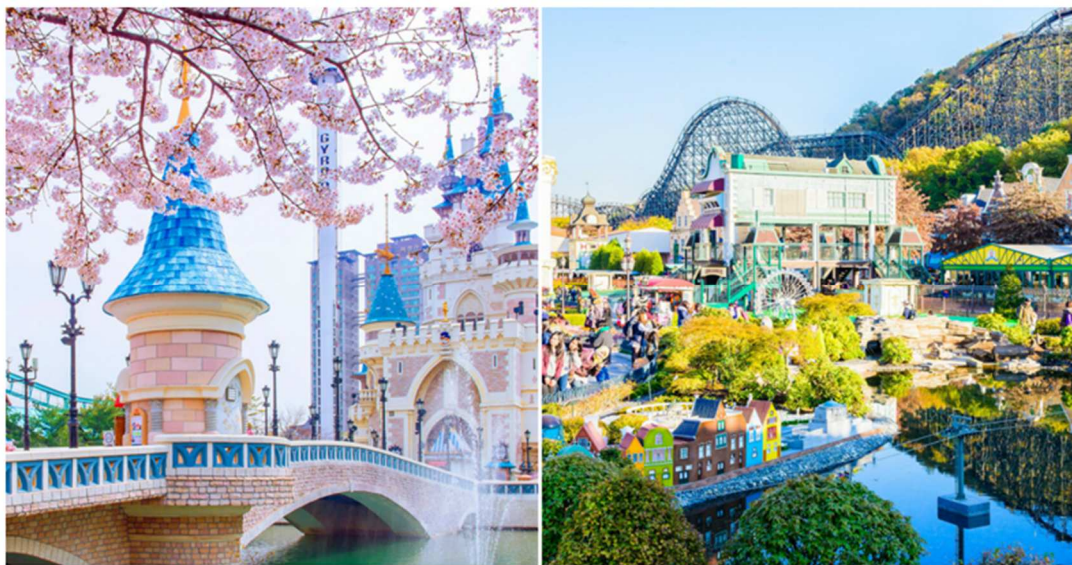

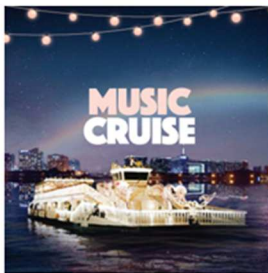

### Soongsil International Summer Friends (Buddy Program)

## V. Visa and Health Insurance

### Visa (D-2-8)

Students will need to obtain a student visa before coming to Korea. In order to obtain a visa, students need to apply at the Korean consulate near their own home. Please consult with the Korean consulate as to what documents are required. The following is a general list required documents for issuing a student visa.

#### Required Documents

- Application Form ([www.hikorea.go.kr](http://www.hikorea.go.kr))
- Passport
- Certificate of Admission (This will be issued by Soongsil University.)
- Certificate of Business Registration (This will be issued by Soongsil University.)
- Proof of Financial Support  
(A bank statement or a scholarship certificate proving that you maintain a minimum balance or have a scholarship certificate to receive a visa)
- Color photos
- Visa processing fee
- Other documents required by the Korean consulate

### Health Insurance

Health insurance is mandatory for all exchange students. You are required to have health insurance which covers the entire length of your stay in Korea. If you purchase health insurance through the International Office, it will cost approximately 50,000 KRW for 1 month.
